Patient Privacy Practices

The privacy provisions of federal law, the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPPA), apply to health information created and maintained by the practice. The Department of Health and Human Service (HHS) has issued the regulation, "Standards for Privacy of Individually Identifiable Health Information", applicable to entities covered by implementing and enforcing the privacy regulation. The privacy standards are designed to provide basic, federal protections for an individual's protected health information. Each state has existing privacy laws that may still apply and to which the practice is already complying. Allergy and Asthma Clinic of Wyoming, LLC is required by law to maintain the privacy of your health information and to provide you with a description of our legal duties and privacy practices regarding your health information. The current notice is given to each patient at their initial consultation and an additional copy is available upon request.
